



Themed Ideas for Your Fall Membership Recruitment Event

Harvest Festival Mixer

· Host a harvest-themed social event with activities like apple bobbing, pumpkin carving, and a cider tasting. Include a section where potential members can learn about your League and sign up on the spot.



Fall Wellness Retreat

· Organize a retreat focusing on wellness and self-care with fall activities like yoga in a scenic location, meditation sessions, and workshops on healthy fall recipes. Use this opportunity to highlight the benefits of joining the American Business Women's Association.



Autumn Networking Brunch

· Host a brunch featuring seasonal foods like pumpkin pancakes and apple cider donuts. Invite speakers or panelists from ABWA (Ambassadors/National Board/Members) to talk about ABWA's impact and benefits, creating an informal environment for potential members to ask questions and network with other quests and members.



Pumpkin Patch Meet-and-Greet


